- 1. Albeit (conj) : although; even if
 - Synonyms: Although, even though
 - Antonyms: Moreover, and furthermore
 - Sentence: He accepted the job, albeit with some hesitation about moving.
- Outbound (adj) : traveling away from a particular point or place, especially referring to vehicles, flights, or travelers
 - Synonyms: Departing, outward-bound
 - Antonyms: Inbound, incoming
 - Sentence: The outbound flights at the airport were delayed due to bad weather.
- 3. Ascribed (verb) : attributed something to a particular cause or source
 - Synonyms: Attributed, assigned
 - Antonyms: Disclaimed, denied
 - Sentence: The villagers ascribed the successful harvest to the blessings of their deity.

- 4. Orchestrate (verb) : to arrange or direct the elements of a situation to produce a desired effect
 - Synonyms: Coordinate, organize
 - Antonyms: Disorganize, disturb
 - Sentence: She orchestrated a surprise birthday party that impressed everyone.
- 5. Overtly (adv) : in a way that is done or shown openly or not secretively
 - Synonyms: Openly, publicly
 - Antonyms: Secretly, covertly
 - Sentence: The company's support for environmental issues was overtly demonstrated through its new green policies.
- 6. Falter (verb) : to lose strength or momentum; to hesitate or waver in action or decision
 - Synonyms: Stumble, hesitate
 - Antonyms: Continue, persevere
 - Sentence: His confidence faltered when he forgot his lines on stage.
- 7. Discernible (adj) : able to be seen or understood; noticeable
 - Synonyms: Perceptible, detectable

- Antonyms: Indiscernible, obscure
- Sentence: There was a discernible change in his mood after he received the news.
- 8. Shenanigan (noun) : mischievous or deceitful behavior or activity
 - Synonyms: Mischief, trickery
 - Antonyms: Honesty, seriousness
 - Sentence: The children were up to some shenanigan in the backyard, trying to build a secret clubhouse.
- 9. Slack (adj) : not tight; loose; lacking in activity, or slow
 - Synonyms: Loose, lax
 - Antonyms: Tight, taut
 - Sentence: The slack rope made it difficult to pull the boat to the shore.

10. Impulse (noun) : a sudden strong desire or urge to act

- Synonyms: Urge, instinct
- Antonyms: Deliberation, premeditation
- Sentence: On an impulse, he bought a ticket to Paris for the weekend.

- 11. Exude (verb) : to display an emotion or quality strongly and openly
 - Synonyms: Radiate, emanate
 - Antonyms: Conceal, hide
 - Sentence: She exudes confidence in every step she takes.
- 12. Elusive (adj) : difficult to find, catch, or achieve; difficult to remember or understand
 - Synonyms: Evasive, slippery
 - Antonyms: Attainable, tangible
 - Sentence: The elusive concept took me a while to understand fully.



- Pakistan becomes the only Asian country to be downgraded to an "authoritarian regime", registering the greatest deterioration of any country in the region classified as "Australia and Asia", according to the Economist Intelligence Unit's (EIU) Democracy Index 2023 report.
