## VOCABULARY

- Parity: the state of being equal, especially the state of having equal pay or position.
  - Synonyms: Equality, Uniformity
  - Antonyms: Disparity, discrepancy, differences
  - Example: We, as a society, should aspire to achieve gender parity
- 2. Archaic: very old-fashioned; no longer used
  - Synonyms: Old, Outmoded
  - Antonyms: Novel, modern, dystopic
  - Example: Texts that were found in the tomb were archaic but clearly visible
- **3.**Microcosm: something that is a small example of something larger.
  - Synonyms: Prototype , specimen
  - Antonyms: Grand, Macrocosm
  - Example: The village is the microcosm of the country.
- **4.**Impede: To slow down something or someone.
  - Synonyms: Disrupt, stop.
  - Antonyms: Support, stimulate.

- Example: Distractions like YouTube, impede your studies.
- **5.**Subterfuge: a secret, usually dishonest, way of behaving.
  - Synonyms: Deviousness, slyness
  - Antonyms: Honesty, Integrity
  - Example: One account suggested that the soldiers used subterfuge to persuade the suspect to open the door.
- **6.**Subvert: To try to destroy or damage a government, religion or political system by attacking it secretly and in an indirect way
  - Synonyms: Oust, overthrow
  - Antonyms:Elevateuplift
- **7.**Flagrant: shocking because it is done in a very obvious way and shows no respect for people, laws, etc.
  - Synonyms: Brazenly, blatantly
  - Antonyms: Slight, complacency
  - Example: The judge called the decision 'a flagrant violation of international law'

- 8.Grim: Very serious , unpleasant situation.
  - Synonyms: Stern, Bleak
  - Antonyms: Cheerful, joyous
  - Example: Climate change is not to be taken lightly keeping in mind the grim state of ice caps.
- **9.**Dismal: something which is of low quality or causes sadness
  - Synonyms: Depressing, Dreary
  - Antonyms: Funny, Hysterical
  - Example: The show was a dismal failure
- **10.** Penalise : To punish someone
  - Synonyms: Chastise, Castigate.
  - Antonyms: Reward, award
  - Example: Instead of penalising the guilty, we should expect remorse.
- **11.** Invoke: to mention or use a law, rule etc. as a reason for doing something
  - Synonyms: Quote, Cite.
  - Antonyms: Quell, subdue.
  - Example: The judge invoked an international law that protects refugees.
- **12.** Brazen it out: to act confidently and not admit that a problem exists.








• Odysseus, a lunar lander built by the aerospace company Intuitive Machines, launched atop a SpaceX rocket on a mission to the moon's south pole.

## The election process

**'Defacement' of ballots:** The bench physically inspected the ballots and found that barring the writing on it made by the presiding

officer (Anil Masih), votes were in favour of the AAP candidate

Plea to conduct poll again: Solicitor general representing Chandigarh admin and advocate for the BJP cadidate suggested fresh elections, but SC rejected this

### **ON PRESIDING OFFICER**

Votes counted afresh: Instead, the top court opted to count the votes and added the 8 "nulled" votes to the tally of 12 votes secured by AAP's Kuldeep Kumar.



The final vote tally according to the SC

"We come to the conclusion that the result declared by presiding officer is patently illegal and is set aside," SC said.

The court blasted Anil Masih and ordered proceedings be initiated against him for "deliberately defacing" ballots and then making false statements "By his conduct he has unlawfully altered course of mayoral election. And in making a solemn statement on Monday, the presiding officer has expressed patent falsehood for which he needs to be held accountable," the bench said.





  - The ISA is an alliance of more than 120 signatory countries that aims to reduce the dependence on non-renewable sources of energy like fossil fuels.


