- 4. Variegated: Exhibiting different colors, patterns, or forms; diversified in appearance.
 - Synonyms: Multicolored, Diverse, Heterogeneous, Assorted.
 - Antonyms: Monochromatic, Uniform, Homogeneous, Plain
 - sentence: The variegated flowers in the garden created a vibrant and visually appealing landscape.
- 5. Minimal: Of a minimum amount, quantity, or degree; barely adequate or the least possible.
 - Synonyms: Bare, Least, Smallest, Modest, Meager.
 - Antonyms: Abundant, Maximum, Excessive, Extensive, Ample.
 - sentence: The room had minimal furniture, creating a clean and uncluttered aesthetic.
- 6. Discourse: Communication of thoughts and ideas; a formal discussion or exposition of a topic.

- 8. Wane: To decrease gradually in size, extent, or degree; to diminish in intensity or power.
 - Synonyms: Decline, Diminish, Decrease, Ebb, Fade.
 - Antonyms: Grow, Increase, Strengthen, Rise, Expand.
 - sentence: The enthusiasm for the project began to wane as challenges emerged.
- 9. Descent: The action of moving downward; a decline, deterioration, or gradual moving away from a higher state.
 - Synonyms: Decline, Drop, Fall, Descent, Deterioration.
 - Antonyms: Ascent, Rise, Improvement, Advancement.
 - sentence: The stock market witnessed a sudden descent, causing concern among investors.
- 10. Testify: To give evidence or testimony under oath; to make a formal statement based on personal knowledge or belief.
 - Synonyms: Attest, Swear, Declare, Witness, Affirm.
 - Antonyms: Deny, Contradict, Refute.
 - sentence: The witness was ready to testify in court about what they had seen during the incident.

- 11. On the Wane: In a state of decline or decrease; diminishing or becoming weaker.

- 12. Pick up pace: To increase speed or progress; to accelerate or move more quickly.




• Dubai has introduced a five-year multipleentry visa to boost travel between India and the Gulf nation, according to the Dubai Department of Economy and Tourism (DET).


