 - sentence: Despite her naive approach, he admired her genuine enthusiasm for the project.
- 2. Bevy (Noun): A large group or collection of people or things of a particular kind; a multitude or abundance.

 - Antonyms: Few, Scarcity, Dearth, Handful.

- Seed (Verb): To initiate or plant the first stages of something; to sow, introduce, or stimulate the development of.
 - Synonyms: Initiate, Plant, Introduce, Inaugurate, Instigate.
 - Antonyms: Halt, Stop, Cease.
 - sentence: The program aims to seed a passion for space exploration in the younger generation through educational initiatives.
- 5. Vacuous (Adjective): Lacking content, substance, or meaningful ideas; empty, devoid of significance.
 - Synonyms: Hollow, Meaningless, Inane, Vapid.
 - Antonyms: Meaningful, Substantial, Full, Thoughtful.
 - sentence: His speech was criticized for being vacuous, lacking any substantial information or insightful content.
- 6. Junked (Verb): Discarded, thrown away, or disposed of as useless or unwanted.
 - Synonyms: Abandoned, Trashed, Scrapped.
 - Antonyms: Kept, Preserved, Retained, Saved.
 - sentence: The old furniture was no longer needed and was junked to make room for new replacements.
- 7. Euphemism (Noun): The use of a mild or indirect expression in place of a harsh or unpleasant one, often to soften the impact or to make it more socially acceptable.

- Synonyms: Substitution, Underplaying, Under statement, Indirect expression, Mildness.
- Antonyms: Bluntness, Directness, Explicitness.
- sentence: The term "let go" is often used as a euphemism for being fired from a job.
- 8. Deleterious (Adjective): Harmful, causing damage to health, well-being, or success.
 - Synonyms: Damaging, Detrimental, Injurious, Adverse.
 - Antonyms: Beneficial, Advantageous, Helpful.
 - sentence: Prolonged exposure to certain chemicals can have deleterious effects on both the environment and human health.
- 9. Exuberance (Noun): The quality of being full of energy, excitement, and enthusiasm; lively and cheerful behavior.
 - Synonyms: Enthusiasm, Vivacity, Zest, Cheerfulness, zeal, jauntiness
 - Antonyms: Lethargy, Dullness, Apathy.
 - sentence: The celebration was marked by an exuberance of laughter, music, and positive energy.
- 10. Sought (Verb): Past tense and past participle of "seek"; looked for, attempted to find, or tried to obtain.
 - Synonyms: Pursued, Looked for, Explored.
 - Antonyms: Ignored, Neglected, Overlooked.
 - sentence: She sought advice from experienced mentors before embarking on her entrepreneurial journey.

- 11. Imputed (Verb): to attribute something discreditable to someone; to assign responsibility or blame.
 - Synonyms: Attribute, Ascribe, Credit, Assign.
 - Antonyms: Absolve, Exonerate, Disregard.
 - sentence: Unfounded rumors were unfairly imputed to the candidate during the election campaign.
- 12. Myriad (Adjective/Noun): Countless or extremely large in number; a vast and indefinite number.
 - Synonyms: Innumerable, Numerous, Abundant, Multitude, Ample, plethora.
 - Antonyms: Limited, Few, Scarce, scant
 - sentence: The forest is home to a myriad of plant and animal species, showcasing the diversity of the ecosystem
- 13. Rejig (Verb): To reorganize, or adjust, especially in order to improve efficiency or functionality.
 - Synonyms: Rearrange, Restructure, Revise, Modify.
 - Antonyms: Maintain, Keep, Preserve.
 - sentence: The company decided to rejig its management structure to adapt to changing market demands.
- 14. Devoid (Adjective): Entirely lacking a certain quality.
 - Synonyms: Empty, Without, Lack, Void, Bereft, Null.



• The company is also in advanced discussions with four additional banks for further collaboration.






- 4. The Philippines has been the first Asian country to ratify a convention to end workplace violence and harassment, the International Labor Organisation (ILO).
