

- 1. Heartening: making you feel happier and more positive.
 - Synonyms: promising, encouraging
 - Antonyms: dreary, gloomy
 - Example: A supportive message from a friend cam be incredibly heartening during tough times.
- 2.Skewed: not accurate or exact
 - Synonyms: distorted, biased
 - Antonyms: fair, impartial
 - Example: His skewed interpretation of the story led to confusion among the listeners.
- 3. Rudimentary: not highly or fully developed
 - Synonyms: basic, elementary
 - Antonyms: advanced, complex
 - Example: The early computers had rudimentary processing power compared to today's advanced technology.

 - Antonyms: hindered, prevented
 - Example: The teacher prompted the students to share their thoughts on the book.
- 8. Deter: to prevent someone from doing something less enthusiastic about doing something.
 - Synonyms: dissuade, inhibit

- Antonyms: encourage, persuade
- Example: the presence of a security guard can deter potential thieves.

9. Inevitable: certain to happen and unable to avoided or prevented.

- Synonyms: inescapable, ineluctable
- Antonyms: avertable, avoidable
- Example: The hanging seasons make the arrival of winter inevitable.
- 10. Consensus: a general agreement.
 - Synonyms: accord, concurrence
 - Antonyms: conflict, opposition
 - Example: the team reached a consensus on the project timeline.
