5. **Enriching** : Making something more meaningful, rewarding, or valuable.
 - Synonyms: Enhancing, uplifting, fulfilling.
 - Antonyms: Depleting, diminishing, impoverishing.
 - Example: Cultural exchange programs contribute to an enriching travel experience by fostering mutual understanding.

6. **Concomitant** : Naturally accompanying or associated.
 - Synonyms: Associated, connected, related.
 - Antonyms: Unrelated, separate, independent.
 - Example: The concomitant increase in pollution levels has led to a rise in respiratory illnesses in the city.

7. **Assimilation** : The process of taking in and fully understanding information or ideas.
 - Synonyms: Absorption, integration, incorporation.
 - Antonyms: Disintegration, separation, rejection.

- Example: The assimilation of different cultures enriches a society, fostering diversity and understanding.
8. **Inculcation** : The instilling of knowledge or values in someone, usually through repetition or persistent teaching.
- Synonyms: Instillation, implantation, indoctrination
 - Antonyms: Neglect, ignorance, disregard.
 - Example: The inculcation of ethical principles is an essential part of a child's upbringing.

- Synonyms: Success, accomplishment, victory.
 - Antonyms: Failure, defeat, setback.
 - Example: Winning the championship was a triumph that brought immense pride to the entire team.

CURRENT AFFAIRS

6th FEBRUARY, 2024

1. India formally launched UPI at the iconic Eiffel Tower here, terming it as taking Prime Minister Narendra-Modi's vision of taking UPI global.
 - UPI formally launched at the iconic Eiffel Tower at the huge Republic Day Reception. Implementing PM @narendramodi's announcement and the vision of taking UPI globally.
2. Northern Ireland's parliament makes history, appointing an Irish nationalist as First Minister for the first time, challenging a century-old pro-British unionist dominance.
3. Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone for the Phase-1 NLC India Talabira Thermal Power Project 3x800 MW (2,400 MW) in Sambalpur, Odisha.
 - The ceremony was attended by Odisha Governor Raghubar Das, Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik, and Union Ministers including Dharmendra Pradhan, Ashwini Vaishnaw, Bishweswar Tudu.

4. INS Karanj, an Indian Navy submarine, arrived in the port of Colombo on Thursday, ahead of Sri Lanka's 76th Independence Day celebrations.
5. Russian cosmonaut Oleg Kononenko set a world record for total time spent in space, surpassing his compatriot Gennady Padalka who logged more than 878 days in orbit.
 - At 0830 GMT Kononenko broke the record, Roscosmos said. Kononenko is expected to reach a total of 1,000 days in space on June 5 and by late September he will have clocked 1,110 days.
6. The Dehradun district administration has imposed Section 144 CrPc within a radius of 300 metres of the Uttarakhand assembly building during the four-day House session beginning on February 5.
7. India's ISRO prepares for an uncrewed Vyommitra Mission in Q3 2024, propelling the nation towards the monumental Gaganyaan mission in 2025.
8. The Ellora– Ajanta International Festival 2024 concludes, its three-day musical celebration captivated audiences in Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar.

- 9.** Dusted Apollo (*Parnassius stenosemus*), a rare high-altitude butterfly has been sighted and photographed for the first time in Himachal Pradesh, indicating the flourishing diversity of Apollo butterflies in the region, bringing cheers to butterfly enthusiasts.
- The butterfly was sighted and photographed in September 2023, during a trek to Manimahesh Lake in Chamba by Gajinder Verma and Abinash Thakur, both forest guards of Chamba Forest Circle, Himachal Pradesh Forest Department. The species was discovered in the year 1890.
