 - sentence: Before closing the factory, they need to dismantle the machinery.
- 7. Posed (Verb): the action of presenting oneself or an idea in a certain way.
 - Synonyms: Put forward, Constituted, Proposed.
 - Antonyms: Withdrew, Renounced, Abstained.
 - sentence: The sudden storm posed a danger to the hikers on the mountain.
- 8. Ambivalence (Noun): having mixed feelings or contradictory attitudes toward someone or something.
 - Synonyms: Uncertainty, Doubtfulness, Equivocation.
 - Antonyms: Certainty, Clarity, Single-mindedness.
 - sentence: His ambivalence about the decision is clear from his conflicted expression.

- 9. Stampede (Noun/ Verb): a sudden rush of people causing chaos and resulting in injuries.
 - Synonyms: Tumult, Panic, Frenzy, Mob.
 - Antonyms: Serenity, Calm, Stability, Tranquility.
 - sentence: The noise of the fireworks caused a stampede as people rushed to exit the crowded stadium.




- 1. Iran announced the successful launch of its domestically manufactured 'Pars-I' remote sensing satellite into orbit using a Russian Soyuz-2.1b rocket.
 - The event marks growing strategic space cooperation between both nations amid shared Western sanctions.

- World Wildlife Day, celebrated annually on March 3, serves as a poignant reminder of the urgent need to protect and preserve the world's fauna and flora.
- The theme for World Wildlife Day 2024, "Connecting People and Planet: Exploring Digital Innovation in Wildlife Conservation."

- 3. A team of archaeologists from Oxford University have excavated a new Harappan site near Dholaviracalled-Lodrani.
- 4. From February 20 to 28, over 1500 military personnel participated in the Eastern Command Anti Tank Guided Missile (ATGM) field firing exercise at Teesta Field Firing Range, West Bengal, India.
 - This annual training operation aimed to enhance proficiency in employing ATGMs under various tactical scenarios.
 - The exercise saw the firing of over 260 missiles, emphasizing the 'One Missile, One Tank' strategy, and included participation from various units of the Infantry and Mechanised Infantry Battalion.
- 5. The Zoological Survey of India named a new marine species of head-shield sea slug with ruby red spot which was discovered from West Bengal and Odisha coast after President of India Droupadi Murmu.
- 6. The Exercise Samudra Laksamana kicked off on February 28 and will continue until March 2, taking place at or off the coast of Visakhapatnam.

- 7. The Indian government has taken a significant step toward becoming selfreliant in semiconductor production by approving the establishment of 3 semiconductor fabrication units.
 - The approvals involve an investment of Rs 1.26 lakh crore (\$15.2 billion) including Rs 76,000 crore support under the 'Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem' programme.
- 8. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the Hindustan Urvarak & Rasayan Ltd (HURL) Sindri Fertiliser Plant in Dhanbad, Jharkhand, marking a milestone since its foundation in 2018.
- 9. The Khelo India University Games 2023 concluded on February 29, 2024, in Guwahati.
 - Chandigarh University emerged as the overall champion of the games with 71 medals, including 32 gold, 18 silver, and 21 bronze.
- 10. In the first UEFA Women's Nations League Final Spain emerged victorious with a 2-0 win.
- 11. 21-ft Maharana Pratap statue unveiled in Hyderabad.
- 12. Cuttack silver Filigree (Chandi Tarakashi) gets Geographical Indication Tag.
