6. **Exoneration**: free from wrongdoing.
- Synonyms: Vindication, Liberation, Acquittal, Absolution.
 - Antonyms: Conviction, Indictment, Blame, Punishment.
 - sentence: The DNA evidence led to her exoneration, proving her innocence beyond doubt.
7. **Pursuit**: the act of chasing something.
- Synonyms: Quest, Search, Expedition, Endeavor.
 - Antonyms: Inactivity, Abandonment, Resignation.
 - sentence: His pursuit of happiness led him on a journey of self-discovery.
8. **Dubious**: something that is doubtful.
- Synonyms: Questionable, Skeptical, Uncertain, Shady.
 - Antonyms: Authentic, Genuine, Reliable, Certain.
 - sentence: She gave dubious response when asked about her whereabouts last night.
9. **Stark**: something that is harsh.
- Synonyms: Bare, Bleak, Severe, Grim.
 - Antonyms: Subtle, Gentle, Mild, Delicate.
 - sentence: The stark reality of the situation hit him hard.

10. **Steady:** a calm or controlled manner.
- Synonyms: Firm, Stable, Unwavering, Constant.
 - Antonyms: Variable, Unstable, Shaky, Erratic.

- International Astronomical Union have identified three new moons in the outer reaches of our solar system.
- Three tiny moons, one orbiting Uranus and two circling Neptune, have been recently confirmed by the International Astronomical Union (IAU), bringing the total number of known moons to 28 around Uranus and 16 around Neptune.

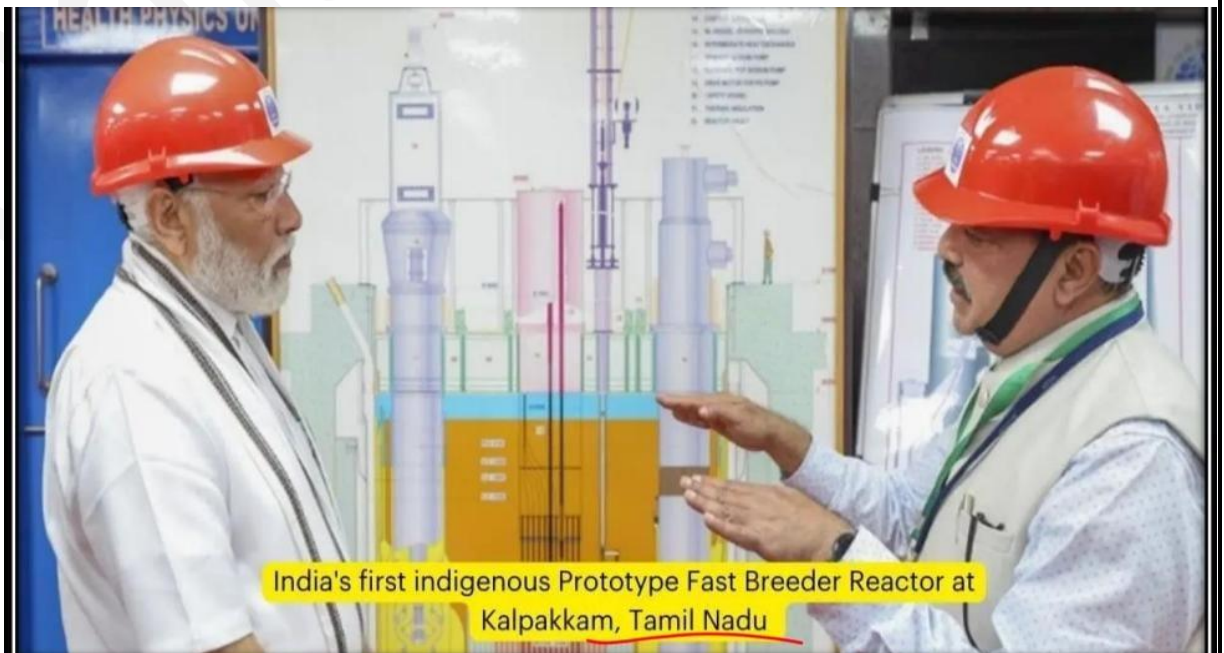
