CURRENT AFFAIRS

1st April, 2024

1. UNESCO has added 18 new sites to its Global Geoparks network, bringing the total to 213 across 48 countries.
 - These new geoparks are located in Belgium, the Netherlands, Brazil, China, Croatia, Denmark, Finland, France, Greece, Hungary, Poland, Portugal, and Spain.
 - Each geopark showcases unique geological features and cultural heritage, contributing to sustainable development and promoting local communities.
2. The Indian Air Force (IAF) is going to conduct the country's largest air military exercise in the name of 'Gagan Shakti-2024'. All the Air Force stations of the country will participate in the ten-day 'Gagan Shakti-2024' exercise.
3. The trailer and song launch of the first Bollywood Hindi film on this subject, "IRAH," took place in Mumbai.
 - The movie features Rohit Bose Roy, Rajesh Sharma, Karishma Kotak, and Rakshith Bhandarry.
4. The government in Uttarakhand has given permission to move four tigers to Rajasthan in response to a request from the western state's authorities.
5. Odisha got its own identity as a separate state in the year 1936, after disassociating itself from Bihar and Bengal. It is believed that the struggle to regain Odisha's lost

identity was initiated by Utkala Sammilani. After branching out as a separate state, Odisha comprised only six districts. Today, the state boasts of 30 districts.

6. China successfully launched the Yunhai-3 02 satellite from the Taiyuan Satellite Launch Center in Shanxi Province, marking a significant advancement in atmospheric and space monitoring capabilities.
 7. Billionaire Gautam Adani-led group on March 28 announced the start of the first phase of the world's largest single-location copper manufacturing plant at Mundra in Gujarat, which will help cut India's dependence on imports and aid energy transition.
 8. The Asian Cricket Council (ACC) announced the upcoming Women's Asia Cup 2024, scheduled to take place in Dambulla, Sri Lanka, from July 19th to July 28th, 2024.
 9. On March 29, 2024, the Indian Navy conducted a successful 12-hour-long operation in the Arabian Sea, rescuing 23 Pakistani nationals from Somali pirates.
- The operation showcased the Indian Navy's tactical expertise and strategic coordination, leading to negotiations with the pirates and their subsequent

surrender without any violence.

- This event marks a significant victory for the Indian Navy in its efforts to combat piracy and ensure the safety of maritime activities in the region.
