## <u>CURRENT AFFAIRS</u> <u>9<sup>th</sup> April, 2024</u>

- 1. The World Economic Forum (WEF) announced its 20th edition of Young Global Leaders Community: The Class of 2024 on 4 April 2024 in Geneva, Switzerland. The list includes nearly 90 young people under 40 years of age from diverse fields of politics, business, civil society, the arts, and academia.
  - This year, five Indians, including the famous film actress Bhumi Pednekar, have been included in the list. Bhumi Pednekar is known for her roles in films like "Dum Laga Ke Haisha", "Toilet: Ek Prem Katha", "Bala", "Shubh Mangal Saavdhan" and "Badhaai ho".
- 2. Singapore, Denmark and U.S. are the best places in the world to conduct business, according to the Economist Intelligence Unit business environment ranking.
- 3. In Slovakia, populist candidate Peter Pellegrini wins the presidential election last night. Russian-friendly, Mr. Pellegrini defeated the pro-Western candidate Ivan Korcok, with 53 percent of the vote, cementing the grip of pro-Russian Prime Minister Robert Fico over the country.
  - The defeated candidate, former Foreign Minister Ivan Korcok is a stalwart supporter of Ukraine and critic of Fico.

- Mount Etna put on a spectacular show for astonished tourists as they watched the volcano blow smoke rings into the sky.
  - The rare phenomenon known as volcanic smoke rings can only form in a circular volcanic vent and requires a calm atmosphere.
  - Despite the name, the rings are not technically made of smoke, instead they are made of condensed gases, mainly water vapour, that has escaped the magma and shot up from the volcano's vent.
- 5. A two-day coastal security exercise called Sagar Kavach 01/24 was conducted off the Lakshadweep Islands from April 1-2, 2024.
- 6. South Korea has successfully launched its second domestically developed military spy satellite into orbit.
  - The satellite, carried by a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket, was launched from an American space centre. This achievement follows the successful launch of
    South Korea's first military spy satellite in December 2022, which was also carried by a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket.
- 7. "The 'Chintan' will be the first-ever conference of the heads of all tri-services institutions.
  - The day-long discussions will be chaired by the Chief of Defence Staff (CDS), General Anil Chauhan.

- Tri-services commanders' conferences (TSCC) are held every year at one of the services' command headquarters.
- 8. The small town of Miraj in Maharashtra's Sangli district is known for its craftsmanship in making musical instruments, particularly sitars and tanpuras.
- 9. Indian badminton players Anupama Upadhyaya and M.Tharun won the women's and men's singles titles, respectively, at the 2024 Kazakhstan International Challenge tournament, held in Uralsk, Kazakhstan. The final was played on 6 April 2024.
  - The Kazakhstan International Challenge Tournament was organised by the Kazakhstan National Badminton Federation in Uralsk, Kazakhstan, from 2-6 April 2024.
- 10. KL Rahul makes history, becomes first Lucknow batter with 1000 IPL Runs.
- 11. Website Booth Raabta launched by Punjab for election related information.
