CURRENT AFFAIRS 15th May, 2024

- 1. Egypt has issued a stern warning to Israel, threatening to nullify the historic Camp David Accords if Israel proceeds with its invasion of Rafah, as reported by Israeli media. This threat comes amidst escalating tensions over Israel's ongoing military operation in Rafah, with the United States reportedly escalating its warnings to Israel regarding its actions in the region.
- 2. India is soon expected to sign a 10-year management agreement for Chabahar Port in Iran. This development is part of India's strategic effort to enhance connectivity with Afghanistan, Central Asia, and the broader Eurasian region. Shipping Minister Sarbananda Sonowal is scheduled to attend the signing ceremony in Iran.
- **3.** Mount Ibu, a volcano in Indonesia's North Maluku province, erupted on Monday, spewing thick grey ash and dark clouds 5,000 meters (16,400 feet) into the sky for five minutes, officials said.
 - "The volcanic earthquakes are still intense so there is a potential for a future eruption," Hendra Gunawan, chief of the Center for Volcanology and Geological Hazard Mitigation said.
- **4.** The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

- 5. Senior BJP leader Sushil Modi died at Delhi's All-India Institute of Medical Sciences Monday evening. The 72- year-old was battling cancer and was admitted in the intensive care unit of AIIMS for the last one month.
- **6.** Pakistan's CubeSat, launched as part of China's Chang'e-6 mission, has achieved a major milestone by sending back its first images of the sun and moon from lunar orbit.
 - The images were unveiled during a ceremony at the China National Space Agency (CNSA) to celebrate the successful mission.
- 7. Ramcharitmanas, Panchatantra and Sahṛdayāloka-Locana of India is among 20 items of the Asia Pacific region which has been included in the 2024 cycle of the 'UNESCO's Memory of the World Asia-Pacific Regional Register'.
- 8. A voter turnout of more than 36 per cent took place in the redrawn Srinagar Lok Sabha seat without any untoward incident on Monday, the highest since 1996 when the constituency in Jammu and Kashmir recorded nearly 41 per cent polling.
