CURRENT AFFAIRS 8th May, 2024

- 1. German private space company Hylmpulse successfully test launched a candle waxpowered rocket "SR75" from a launch site in Koonibba, South Australia.
 - It is for the 1st-time a rocket carrying commercial satellites on a test suborbital flight into space.
- 2. The Oxford Bookstores named Bhavi Mehta as the winner of the 9th edition of Oxford Bookstore Book Cover Prize 2024. The event was held at the India Habitat Centre and celebrated Mehta's work on "The Book Beautiful" by Pradeep Sebastian, published by Hachette India. Mehta received a trophy, certificate, and a cash prize of INR 1 lakh.
- 3. According to the official Facebook page of the Capital Development Authority (CDA), which is responsible for the upkeep of Islamabad, the Metropolitan Corporation of Islamabad has launched "Free yoga classes in F-9 Park" in the capital.
- 4. José Raúl Mulino has won Panama's presidential election after three of his nearest rivals conceded defeat. The 64-year-old former security minister has secured nearly 35% of the counted votes, with more than 92% of the votes counted. He has an unassailable 9 per cent lead over his nearest rival.
