Instructions for filling Online Application Form of Civil Services Examination, 2025 & Indian Forest Service Examination, 2025

Important

THE COMMISSION HAS IMPLEMENTED A NEW REGISTRATION AND ONLINE APPLICATION FORM. FOR THE CIVIL SERVICES EXAMINATION, 2025, AND THE INDIAN FOREST SERVICE EXAMINATION, 2025. CANDIDATES ARE REQUESTED TO NOTE THAT THEY ARE REQUIRED TO UPLOAD ALL THE REQUISITE DETAILS AND DOCUMENTS INCLUDING MATRICULATION CERTIFICATE, EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATES, COMMUNITIY/PWBD CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE), NECESSARY UNDERTAKINGS (WHEREVER APPLICABLE) IN REGISTRATION AND ONLINE APPLICATION FORM WHICH SHALL REMAIN OPEN FORM 22ND JANUARY 2025 TO 11TH FEBRUARY 2025.

Applicants for the Civil Services Examination, 2025, or the Indian Forest Service Examination, 2025, must upload all required documents during this application window. To avoid last-minute rush and complications, candidates are encouraged to have their required certificates ready and submit their applications well in advance."

- 1. Applicants are advised to carefully go through the detailed Notice No. 05/2025-CSP & 06/2025-IFS, which can be viewed on the website of the Commission (https://upsc.gov.in/) as well as the website https://upsconline.gov.in.
- 2. All the candidates are advised that before filling up the Online Application Form (OAF) for the Civil Services Examination (CSE) 2025 / Indian Forest Service (IFoS) Examination 2025 / both, they must register themselves through ONE TIME REGISTRATION (OTR) using the URL https://www.upsconline.gov.in.
- 3. Before applying for the CSE 2025 / IFoS Examination 2025, the candidates are requested to check their eligibility (w.r.t. minimum educational qualification, age etc.) given in the **Notice of the Examination concerned**, available on Commission's website.

- 4. Candidate should have details of one Photo ID Card viz. Aadhaar Card / Voter Card (EPIC)/ PAN Card / Passport / Driving License / Any other Photo ID Card issued by the State / Central Government. The details of this Photo ID will be used for all future references and the candidate is advised to carry this Photo ID Card while appearing for the Examination/Personality Test.
- 5. The candidates who are required to pay the examination fee must ensure that the fee is paid by them. The examination fees once paid, either for CSE or IFoS will not be refunded under any circumstances. It may also be noted that fee once paid for one application is not allowed to be adjusted against another application.
- 6. Candidates appearing in CSE 2025 / IFoS Examination, 2025 will be required to indicate following information in OAF:
 - i. Detail of examination centers for Civil Services (Main) Examination and Indian Forest Service (Main) Examination (if opted),
 - ii. Optional subject(s) to be selected for the examination,
 - iii. Medium of Examination for Civil Services (Main) Examination,
 - iv. Medium of Examination for Optional Subject if he/she chooses any, Indian Language as the Medium of Examination for Civil Services (Main) Examination,
 - v. Compulsory Indian Language for Civil Services (Main) Examination at the time of the filling up online application itself, and
 - vi. Service Preferences for Civil Services Examination.
- 7. While filling in his/her Application Form, the candidate should carefully decide about his/her **choice of centre** for the Examination. If any candidate appears at a centre other than the one indicated by the Commission in his/her e-Admit Card, the papers of such a candidate will not be evaluated and his/her candidature will liable to cancellation.
- 8. Suitable provisions for information regarding use of scribes by the Candidates (PwBD/PwD) who are eligible to avail the facility of scribe (as prescribed in the Rules) have been made in the OAF at the time of the initial OAF itself.
- 9. Applicants are requested to note that before filling the OAF they may have a careful look on the common reasons where an applicant's online application is being rejected by the Commission. Applicants are therefore advised to be careful enough so that chances of their applications being rejected are minimized to the best possible extent and their effort is not lost due to the reasons which can be avoided by them if theyremain slightly more careful while submitting their application to the Commission.
- 10. The Experience of Commission (UPSC) shows that major rejection happens

due to the following reasons:

- a) Application being rejected on the grounds of bad quality of submitted photograph.
- b) Application being rejected on the grounds of bad quality of submitted signature.
- c) Application being rejected on the grounds of swapping of photograph with that of signature.
- d) Applicant have filled all the details in OAF but failed to finally submit the OAF before the closing date.
- e) Fee Payment details against one application has been submitted to another application ID (Fee once paid against one application, is not allowed to be adjusted against another application*).
- f) Application being rejected on the grounds of non-submission of payment proof to the Commission within specified time in case of fictitious payment. [Fictitious payment cases are those cases for which the Commission does not receive any information from the bank authorities to which the applicant has claimed to have deposited his/her fees.]

*cases (which are intimated to the applicant through e-mail as well as published on thewebsite of the Commission within 2 weeks after the last date of receipt of online application).

- 11. Candidates applying online need NOT send hard copy of the OAF filled by them online or any other document / certificate / testimonial to the Union Public Service Commission. However, they are advised to take printout of the OAF and retain it for further communication with the Commission.
- 12. The Candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions for admission to examination. Their admission at all the stages of the examination will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.
- 13. Mere issue of admission certificate to the candidate will not imply that his candidature has been finally cleared by the Commission. The Commission takes up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents at subsequent stages of examination process.
- 14. Online Application process must be completed before 1800 hours of 11th February, 2025.
- 15. In the interest of coordinated and secured logistics, the Commission may not operate Centres where the number of candidates is very low. In such cases, the Commission may allot nearest Centres to the candidates. THE DECISION OF THE COMMISSION IN THIS REGARD WILL BE FINAL AND NO FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERTAINED FROM CANDIDATES.

- 16. The Centres and the dates of holding the Main Examination as mentioned above are liable to be changed at the discretion of the Commission. While every effort will be made to allot the candidate to the Centre of his choice, the Commission may, at their discretion allot a different Centre or a new Centre that may be opened when circumstances so warrant.
- 17. The candidates should note that under no circumstances they will be allowed to change optional subject, Indian language paper (Paper-A) and medium of examination that they have already indicated in their filled online Civil Services OAF.
- 18. No request for withdrawal of candidature received from a candidate after he / she has submitted his/her application will be entertained.
- 19. If any candidate appears,
 - i. in an optional subject other than the one indicated by the Commission in his /her e-Admit Card; or
 - ii. in an Indian language paper other than the one indicated by the Commission in his e-Admit Card.

PAPERS OF SUCH A CANDIDATE WILL NOT BE EVALUATED, AND THE CANDIDATURE WILL BE LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED.

- 20. The e-admit cards will be uploaded in the Commission's website. The candidates should download the same and check it carefully to ensure that the particulars on the e-Admit Card are correct. In case, there is any mistake in the e-Admit Card, it should be brought to the notice of the Commission with a request to issue the correct e-Admit Card. Candidates may note that they will not be allowed to take the examination on the strength of e-Admit Card issued in respect of another candidate. No candidate will be allowed to take the examination without the e-admit card.
- 21. The Roll No. of the candidate for the Main Examination will be the same as the Roll Number given to him/ her for the Preliminary Examination.
- 22. Persons in Government service whether in a permanent or temporary capacity or as work charged employees other than casual or daily rated employees or those serving under Public Enterprises are required to **upload** an undertaking (**ANNEXURE-I**) that they have informed in writing their Head of Office/ Department that they have applied for the Examination. Candidates should note that in case a communication is received from their employer by the Commission withholding permission to the candidates applying for/ appearing at the Examination, their applications will be liable to be rejected/candidature will be liable to be cancelled. (**Please refer Rule 8 of CSE Rules, 2025 / and Rule 9 of IFoS Rules, 2025).**

- 23. A candidate appearing in the examination should also bring with him/ her to the examination hall extra copies of the photograph similar to the one uploaded in the application form, as per the instructions given in the e-Admit Card.
- 24. A candidate who claims to belong to one of the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes or the Other Backward Classes(OBCs) should upload in support of his/her claim a scanned copy of the certificate in the prescribed format (ANNEXURE-II/III) from the District Officer or the Sub-Divisional Officer or any other Officer as indicated in the prescribed format, of the district in which his/ her parents (or surviving parent) ordinarily reside, who has been designated by the State Government concerned as competent to issue such a certificate. If both his/her parents are deceased, the officer signing the certificate should be of the district in which candidate himself/herself ordinarily resides otherwise than for the purpose of his/her own education. 24.1 A candidate who claims reservation benefit under Economically Weaker Section (EWS) should upload in support of his/her claim a scanned copy of the Income and Asset Certificate in the prescribed format (ANNEXURE-IV)

Note 1: Candidates should note that their SC/ST/PwBD/Ex-servicemen certificate should have been issued latest by the closing date of OAF for CSE 2025/IFoS Examination 2025 [i.e. 11.02.2025] as prescribed in the Rule 27 of the CSE 2025/Rule 20 of the IFoS Examination 2025.

Note 2: EWS Category candidates should note that 'Income and Asset Certificate' must be issued in prescribed format based on the income for Financial Year 2023-24 (i.e. for the period 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024) in support of their claim. Certificate based on the income of any other Financial Year shall not be treated as valid. The Certificate must be issued on/after 01.04. 2024 (after the completion of FY 2023-24) but not later than the closing date of the application for Civil Services (Preliminary) Examination-2025 i.e 11.02.2025. Such candidates must meet the Income and Asset criteria issued by the Central Government.

Note 3: The OBC category candidates should note that the OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) certificate must be in prescribed format based on the income for the Financial Years (FYs) 2023-24, 2022-23 and 2021-22. The Certificate must be issued on/after 01.04.2024 (after the completion of FY 2022-23) but not later than the closing date of the application for Civil Services (Preliminary) Examination-2025 i.e. Candidates should also note that the name of their caste (including its spellings) as indicated in their certificates, should be exactly the same as published in the lists notified by the Central Government from time to time. A certificate containing any variation in the caste name will not be accepted.

Note 4: The OBC/SC/ST claim of a candidate will be determined in relation to the State (or part of the State) to which his father originally belongs. A candidate who has migrated from one State (or part of the State) to another should, therefore, produce an OBC/SC/ST certificate which should have been

issued to him based on his father's OBC/SC/ST certificate from the State to which he (father) originally belongs.

- Note 5: No change in the community status indicated by a candidate in his/her OAF for the CSE 2025 / IFoS 2025 / both will be allowed by the Commission except in the circumstances mentioned in the Rule 26 of CSE Rules, 2025 and Rule 23 of IFoS Rules, 2025
- 25. A candidate disabled while in the Defence Services claiming age concession should <u>upload/</u>produce certified copy of the certificate in the prescribed form (ANNEXURE-VII) from the Director General Resettlement, Ministry of Defence to certify that he was disabled while in the Defence Services in operations during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof.
 - 25.1 Ex-servicemen including Commissioned Officers and ECOs/SSCOs claiming age concession in terms of Rule 5(2)(d) or 5(2)(e) of the Rules for the Examination should produce an attested/certified copy of the certificate as applicable to them along with undertaking (if applicable), in the forms prescribed at ANNEXURE-VIII, from the authority concerned.
- 26. Exemption from Paper A on Indian Language in CSE (Main) 2025: The Paper-A on Indian Language will not be compulsory for candidates hailing from the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalya, Mizoram, Nagaland and Sikkim. Accordingly, such candidates will be required to upload a certificate to that effect from the same authorities as are empowered, to issue certificates in regard to SC/ST/OBC candidates (see para 24 above). These certificates will have to be issued by the competent authorities of the above States only. Prescribed format of the certificate is given at ANNEXURE-IX.
 - 26.1. The paper A on Indian Language will not, however, be compulsory for candidates of Persons with Benchmark Disability (only Hearing Impaired) provided that they have been granted such exemption from 2nd or 3rd language courses by the concerned education Board/University. The candidate needs to provide an undertaking/self-declaration in this regard in order to claim such exemption. The format of declaration/under-taking is given at **ANNEXURE-X**.
- 27. A candidate belonging to Persons with Benchmark Disability category shall be required to meet one or more of the physical requirements/abilities, as laid down in Rule 25 of the Rules for the Civil Services Examination, 2025 and upload scanned Certificate of Disability (ANNEXURE-XI) in Form V / Form VI / Form VII/ others issued by notified Medical Authority of the Central/State Government. Such Disability Certificate should have been issued latest by the closing date for submission of online application form for Civil Services Examination 2025 (i.e. 11.02.2025) as prescribed in Rule 28 of the Rules of the examination.

- 28. Candidates must note that they use only international form of Indian numerals in the filling of the application form and writing the Code Numbers e.g. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, etc. Only the Code Numbers as thus filled-in will be taken into consideration. They should take special care to see that the entries made in the application form are correct and true. In case there are any misleading entries, the candidates will be responsible for the consequences thereof.
- 29. E-Admit Card issued for admission to the Main Examination are liable to be cancelled, at the discretion of the Commission for valid reasons such as misrepresentation or serious deficiencies in the candidature of the candidate.
- 30. Candidates are required to indicate in the OAF about the language medium in which they would like to be interviewed at the time of Interview for Personality Test as below (Please refer Rule 15(2) of CSE Rules, 2025):(a) The candidates, opting for Indian Language medium for the written part of the Civil Services (Main) Examination, may choose either the same Indian Language or English or Hindi as the medium for the interview.
 - (b) The candidates, opting to write the Civil Services (Main) Examination in English, may choose as the medium for interview either English, or Hindi, or any other Indian Language opted by them for the compulsory Indian Language Paper in the written part of the Civil Services (Main) Examination. However, the candidates, who are exempted from the compulsory Indian Language Paper, will have to choose either English or Hindi as medium of Interview for Personality Test.
- 31. Candidates should note that in CSE (Main) 2025 / IFoS (Main) 2025 Examination, instead of separate Question Paper and Answer Book, a consolidated Question Paper-cum-Answer book (QCAB), having space below each part/sub part of a question shall be provided to them for writing the answers. Candidates shall be required to attempt answer to the part/sub-part of a question strictly within the pre-defined space. Any attempt outside the pre-defined space shall not be evaluated. Marks may be deducted as PENALTY for violating any of the instructions contained in the QCAB.
- 32. Candidates applying for CSE 2025 should note that in no circumstances will they be allowed a change in the language medium of Interview for Personality Test which they have indicated in their OAF.
- 33. Candidates applying for CSE 2025 should note that evaluation of the papers, namely, Essay, General Studies and Optional Subject of all the candidates would be done simultaneously along with evaluation of their qualifying papers on 'Indian Languages' and 'English' but the papers on Essay, General Studies and Optional Subject of only such candidates will be taken cognizance who attain 25% marks in Indian Language and 25% marks in English as minimum qualifying standards in these qualifying papers.

- 34. In all communication with the Commission regarding his/her OAF the candidate should mention the name of the Examination, his/her Roll Number, Name and his/her Date of birth.
 - A candidate must see that communication sent to him at the address stated in his OAF is redirected, if necessary. Any change in address should be communicated to the Commission at the earliest opportunity. Although the Commission makes every effort to take account of such changes, they cannot accept any responsibility in the matter.
- 35. The Candidates should note that their candidature at all the stages of the CSE 2025 / IFoS Examination 2025 will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. If on verification at any stage before or after the Main (Written) examination and Interview Test, it is found that they do not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions; their candidature for the examination will be cancelled by the Commission.

NOTE: CANDIDATES QUALIFIED FOR INTERVIEW FOR THE PERSONALITY TEST ON THE RESULTS OF THE WRITTEN PART OF THE MAIN EXAMINATION WILL BE REQUIRED TO PRODUCE THE ORIGINALS OF THE REQUISITE CERTIFICATES. FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE REQUIRED CERTIFICATES IN ORIGINAL AT THAT TIME WILL ENTAIL CANCELLATION OF CANDIDATURE.
