CURRENT AFFAIRS

26th May, 2025

1. Saudi Arabia unveiled TOURISE on May 22, 2025, a global collaborative platform that brings together leaders from tourism, technology, investment, and sustainability sectors. Launched by the Tourism Minister Ahmed Al-Khateeb, TOURISE seeks to unlock new investment opportunities and tackle challenges.
2. Novak Djokovic became just the third man in the Open era to win 100 ATP singles titles on Saturday, defeating Hubert Hurkacz 5 7 , 7 6 (7 2) , 7 in the final of the Geneva Open . The 24 time grand slam winner joins Jimmy Connors and Roger Federer as the only men to have achieved the feat.
3. Kush Maini became the first Indian to win the Formula 2 Sprint Race at the Monaco Grand Prix. After he won, business tycoon Anand Mahindra praised him for the stupendous achievement .
4. Known as the 'paradise of birds', Keoladeo National Park in Rajasthan is also emerging as a sanctuary for turtles, offering shelter to eight out of 10 species found in the state. This makes the park one of the richest turtle habitats in the region, besides its significance in avian life.
5. The 10th Governing Council Meeting of the National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog was held in New Delhi on 24 May 2025. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who is also the ex officio Chairman of the NITI Aayog, chaired the meeting. The Governing Council is the highest decision-making body of the NITI Aayog and meets annually.
6. Chhonzin Angmo scripted history by becoming the first visually-impaired woman from India and the fifth such person in the world to scale Mt Everest, planting the Tricolour on Earth's highest mountain.
7. Wings India 2026, India's flagship civil aviation event, is scheduled to take place in Hyderabad from January 28 to 31. This major biennial gathering, organized by the Ministry of Civil Aviation along with the Airport Authority of India and FICCI, will be hosted at Begumpet Airport.

8. The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has filed a charge sheet against former Jammu and Kashmir Governor Satya Pal Malik and five others in the KiruHydroelectric Power Project kickbacks case. In 2022, the Jammu and Kashmir government requested a CBI investigation into the alleged corruption in the allotment of a 2,200-crore-rupee contract for civil works in the KiruHydroelectric Power Project.
9. England ' s celebrated batsman Joe Root made history by becoming the quickest player to amass 13,000 in Test cricket. Achieving this in just his 153 runs rd match during a one off Test against Zimbabwe at Trent Bridge, Root broke Jacques Kallis ' previous record
